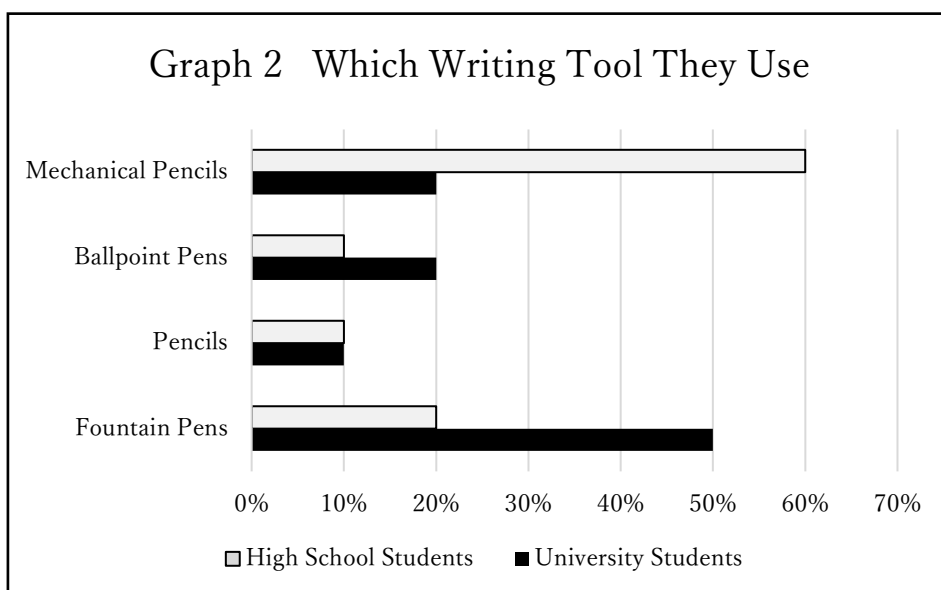
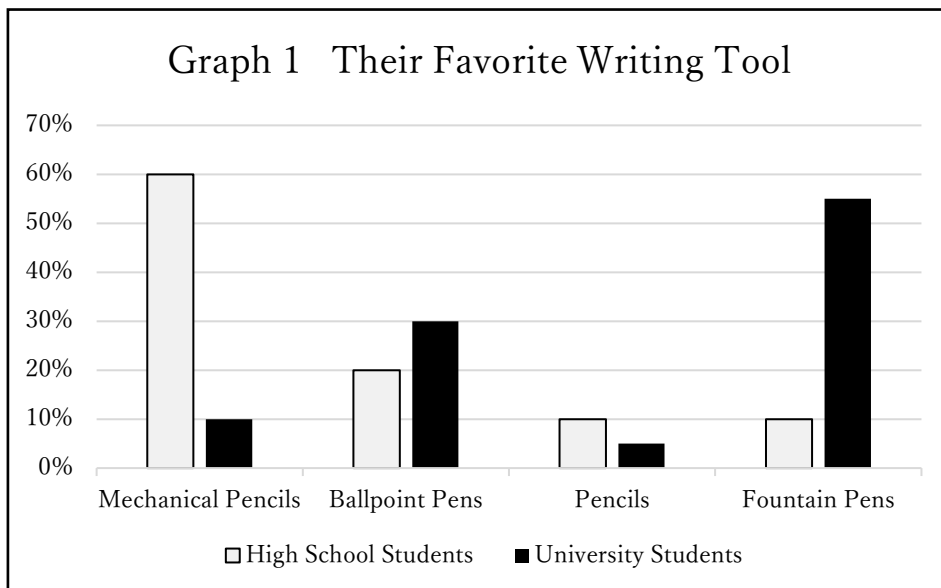

What is your favorite drink? My friends and I enjoy drinking coffee. But how much do we know about our coffees? When we get expert *knowledge, we'll be connoisseurs. My friends and I are on our journey to become "coffee connoisseurs," so we tried to figure out the basics of coffee - types, roast and water use.

The first thing you need to know is that there are two types of coffee. One of them is called *Arabica and the other is called *Robusta. Do you know the difference? Well, Arabica coffee has a better and *smoother taste. On the other hand, Robusta coffee has a bitter taste which some people might not like very much. The Robusta coffee has more *caffeine than Arabica coffee. *Personally, I like Arabica coffee better because of its smoother taste, but most of my friends like more caffeine. So they love the Robusta coffee. The major difference is that Arabica is more expensive than Robusta. When you buy your coffee, you can see the name of the package: Arabica or Robusta. Or, you can guess with their *price tags. If you want to have both the taste of the Arabica and Robusta coffee, there are actually stores that sell a mix of both.

Coffees have different types of roasts: light roast, *medium roast, and dark roast. Light roast has a lighter *shade of brown color. It has no oil on the *surface of the beans, has the highest *acidity and keeps most of the caffeine from the coffee bean. If you want more caffeine and acidity flavor, light roast coffee is the best! Medium roast has a brown color that is a little darker than light roast. It doesn't have any oil on the surface of the beans and has a more balanced flavor, with aroma, and acidity between dark and light roast. Dark roast beans are roasted at higher *temperatures than the others, so it has the dark brown color. It has an oily surface on the beans, a bitter taste, and the least caffeine.

Lastly, the water you use to make coffee plays an important role when you want to make your own better cup of coffee. The quality of your coffee is as good as the quality of your water. The best idea is to use mineral water.

Now, we have basic information about the world of coffee. Which one would you like to try?

But the Netherlands also has the highest *supply of natural gas, a fossil fuel,

in the world. 50 percent of our natural gas comes from the largest gas field in Europe, the Groningen gas field. You might be thinking: Why doesn't the Netherlands switch all of its energy to wind power? It's just not that easy. We are lucky because we already have access to different types of energy. But lots of countries are poorer and they can't change their systems so quickly. To change them into "clean energy" is very expensive.

Our country finally plans to stop *production from Groningen field by 2022, but I'm worried that many people will lose their jobs when this happens. Clean energy might be good for the environment, but is it always the best idea for the economy?
